- 5. Zoom requires internet and a technology device. If you do not have one of these or both, please e-mail Mr. Sittig. We will place a Chromebook and charger in the student's bag when they pick it up on March 24th if they need it.
- 6. If we are not back in session for school, work needs to be dropped off on Monday, March 30th. During this time, you will pick up the next week of work. (This is only if we are not in school). If we are back in school students may bring their work to school that day. Please drop off your work in the bag that it was in when you picked it up. I will grade the papers and return them once they are in the gradebook.
