- Math: This week we started multiplying by 10, 100, and 1,000. If your child hasn't practiced their basic multiplication facts in awhile now would be a great time to get out those flash cards. You can also go onto my website for some fun online math games or let me know if you would like me to send home some flashcards.
- Reading: This week we read a tale title *The Horned Toad Prince*. This was a fun story to work on our fluency and expression. We also revisited author's purpose. Have your child practice reading aloud this weekend using expression. Don't forget to keep track of your child's reading this month on the September reading calendar. The calendar will be due back at the end of the month.
- Science: this week students learned about sound energy. Next week we will be exploring with light energy using flashlights and water to see if we can break up the light.
- **Social Studies:** This week students discussed weather and climate and what affects those. We also discussed natural resources.
